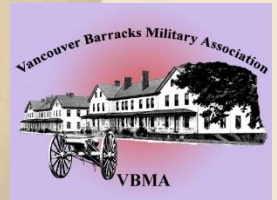

Title: Waiting for the Cold War to Heat Up

After World War II, the Vancouver Barracks went from being the Pacific Northwest's premier Regular Army post to a military backwater. This change had impacts in the local community that are still felt today. From the late 1940s to 2011, the Vancouver Barracks became the home to many Army Reserve and National Guard units. Units that drew their soldiers from the local community. Who were the major units at the Vancouver Barracks? And what significant activities happened there?

These events are tied in with Major Jeff Davis' life. His father was stationed at the Vancouver Barracks, and Jeff himself enlisted in the Vancouver Barracks in 1979. He was one of the last soldiers to serve at the Vancouver Barracks, in 2011.
